Red Wines

- 8 **Merlot, Arapala Sky, Central Valley, Chile** (C) 13% vol
Heady aromas of rich black cherry and plum with flavours of sour cherry and a hint of mocha ending in a long, smooth finish.

- 9 **Shiraz, Goldfields, South Australia** (B)
A soft, supple Shiraz, with deep black fruit aromas and hints of spice and pepper.

- 10 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Rue des Amis, Languedoc, France** (C) 13% vol
Dark ruby red with a powerful bouquet of ripe fruit with hints of herbs and spice. Firm and round to taste with structured length.

- 11 **Rioja, Azabache, Spain** (C) 14% vol
